ENTRY RULES

3 Entry categories:

2 person crews only consisting of:

adult and adult or adult and child (12 & under) or child and child (12 & under)

Race Rules:

In order to place for a trophy during the boat races, both crew members must be in their boat as they cross the finish line.

Life jackets must be worn by all participants while racing.

Participants must supply their own life jackets and paddles.

A race number will be assigned to each team.

All boats must be removed from the beach after the race is completed.

Race Route:

3 race routes

One for each entry category.

Registration fee/deadline:

\$30.00 per boat by July 10.

Each participant will receive an event t-shirt.

Awards will be given in the following categories:

Best in show

Most likely to float

Titanic (most likely to sink)

First place winner in each category

Rules for building an eligible boat:

Boats must be made of cardboard - no metal, wood, or rigid foam (ie: Styrofoam or plastic)

Builder may use glue, sealant, wax, paint, duct tape, sona-tubes and wax cardboard only.

No motors are allowed.

Paddles may be of wood or plastic

Boat name must be clearly visible on the boat

Boats will be disqualified if all rules are not adhered to
